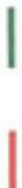

This is in reference to your letter dated October 22, 2012 enquiring the proper procedure to contact the department that originally sent a letter in 1975 to Mr. Howard Keresey, the administrator of the estate of your great-grandfather, Mr. James Churchward, regarding an archeological discovery in the Valley of Mexico area that is referenced in Mr. Churchward's books.

In this regard, please be advised that the Departamento del Distrito Federal (DDF) was formally extinguished in 1997 due to a series of constitutional amendments and was replaced by the Government of the Federal District.

However, according to Mexican legislation, the National Institute of Anthropology and History (INAH) is the agency responsible for preserving Mexico's pre-hispanic heritage. Therefore, I suggest that you address your inquiry to:
